

# Company Sponsorship

Weekend, Evening, and Online MBA Programs

Roughly half of our part-time students receive company sponsorship.

## Types of Potential Assistance

- Percentage sponsorship of tuition and fees, from 20%-100%.
- Specific dollar amount of sponsorship, capped per semester, year, course, or credit hour.
- Company promise of sponsorship with time commitment to company after degree completion.

## Program Details

- The Weekend Program is a two-year, lockstep, cohort model where students are on campus for classes every other weekend. It also includes some distance learning. Students take a set of required core courses and choose from a predetermined set of electives. Classes run from 4-9 p.m. Friday and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- The Evening Program offers local candidates weekday evening classes starting around 6 or 7 p.m. and ending at 9 or 10 p.m. Students take a set of required core courses and a variety of electives of their choosing. It also includes some online course options. Most students finish in three or four years.
- The Online Program allows maximum flexibility. The curriculum includes a mix of live interactive classes, self-guided modules, and residential immersion experiences. Students take a set of required core courses and a variety of electives of their choosing. Most students will finish in three or four years.
- Our signature MAP course—involving an immersive, real-world business challenge—is required in the Weekend and Online programs, and optional in the Evening program.
